

SCFC U9 AND UP DIVISION 3 & 4 COACHING POCKET HANDBOOK

1. BAYSA Handbook – published each year, found on BAYSA website. Contains policies and procedures that each club must abide by.
 - a. Roster sizes – Set by BAYSA
 - i. U9-U10 – 10 players, 6v6 format with goalie, no off sides
 - ii. U11-U12 -14 players, 8v8 format with goalie, off sides
 - iii. U13 and up – 18 players, 11v11 format (spring season plays 6v6 on 8v8 field, max roster of 10 players. Off sides
2. Player ID cards -
 - a. Photo attached, signed by player and laminated before 1st game - NO EXCEPTIONS
 - b. Coach keeps on a key ring – they belong to player if they need to go to tournament.
 - c. If lost, cards are only printed on Tuesdays, so notify VP2 an registrar, \$5.00 charge for reprint
3. Game cards -
 - a. Printed the week of the game – one game at a time
 - b. LOGIN= **space city** (yes, space between words) PASSWORD= **baysa**
 - i. Print 2 copies in case other coach doesn't have one.
 - ii. Absolutely NO WRITE-ins. If player is not listed, let registrar and VP2 know immediately
 - iii. REVIEW before you sign it, be sure score is correct
 - iv. Must be turned in by 8 pm on Sunday of your weekend game. \$25 charge for no Game card. Can work with regional scorekeepers if necessary.
4. The Season
 - a. Practices are normally twice a week, M/W or T/TH, either at 5:30 -7:00 or 7:00 -8:30.
 - i. In the best interest of developing players, the club encourages ages to practice in proximity/together.
 - b. Games
 - i. Schedules are created by the BAYSA scheduler - reschedules (Fall Only) are also handled by BAYSA.
 - ii. Schedule can be found online at striker7.com
 - iii. Fall season- most games on Saturday, although there will be Sunday scheduled games
 1. Spring season – most games on Sunday afternoon, although there may be Saturday games also.
 - iv. (FALL ONLY) Dependent on number of teams in each bracket, fall season will consist of 9 games. The first four will be used for seeding purposes. After the first 4 games, BAYSA will hold a meeting to determine the number of teams that will play in either Gold, Silver or Bronze bracket and after that, teams will play in the respective brackets as well as Playoffs at the end of the season. Coaches are welcome to attend this meeting in order to have input into the bracketing.
 - v. Referees are supplied through BAYSA
 1. U9-U12 = 1 referee typical
 2. U13 and up = 1 Center Ref + 2 assistant ref (typically)
5. STATUS ME – Field closing and opening notification via text or email or phone. –Recommend all parents to sign up – you won't have to make any calls.
